



JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

WATER TREATMENT OPERATOR - The Scott County Public Service Authority (SCPSA) is accepting applications for the Part-time position of Water Treatment Operator. This position of Part-time Water Treatment Operator is responsible for helping operate, organize and participate in the water production and water distribution activities of SCPSA.

Successful candidates must have a high school diploma or equivalent (GED) and a valid driver's license. Applicants possessing a Virginia Waterworks Operator License Class 1, 2, or 3 are preferred. Applicants possessing a Virginia Waterworks Operator License Class 4, 5, or 6 may be considered. Applicants with no Virginia Waterworks Operator license but possessing a college degree with an emphasis on water and wastewater treatment may also be considered. Possession of a Virginia Wastewater Operator License is a plus.

Familiarity with Commonwealth of Virginia *Waterworks Regulations* is desired. Successful applicants must be able to work days, nights, weekends and holidays. License class and experience will be used to determine the wage rate.

Applicants must submit a completed official SCPSA application. Applications may be accompanied with a resume and a cover letter.
